3CX

The Robin SmartView (SV) and the Robin SIP are compatible with the 3CX platform.

Configuration of 3CX.

Create a extension on the 3CX system for the Robin Intercom. Extension login and password will be used later in the Robin Intercom.

Configuration of the Robin

- 1. Log-on to the Robin and navigate to the -Telephony-SIP- menu
- 2. At SIP proxy / Registar, enter the 'Default domain' of the 3CX
- 3. At Authentication user, enter the 3cx 'ID'
- 4. At Password
- 5. Enable "Register"
- 6. "Apply settings"

The Robin will now register itself.
