Software version 3 can be installed on the following Robin products:

Robin ProLine SIP (1, 2, 4 buttons or keypad)
Robin Compact SIP
Robin ProLine SV SIP (1, 2, 4 buttons or keypad)
Robin ProLine SIP Compact
Robin Classic SV SIP (1, 2, 4 buttons)
Robin Compact SV SIP

! Note: Firmware version 3.6.10 has default security settings enabled that will prevent access to the WEB interface of the Robin from anywhere but the LAN (IP-subnet of the Robin). This security measure can be undone after the upgrade is finished, in the -System-Security- menu if necessary. It will be activated 30 minutes after reboot of the Robin, so you can update the firmware to 3.6.9, reboot the unit, access it for 30 minutes which allows you to disable this setting. You can always regain access to the WEB interface of the Robin for a period of 30 minutes by power cycling the device. !

- *Microsoft Teams compatibility. Using the CyberGate service from CyberTwice (cybertwice.com) the Robin can be fully integrated (audio and video) with Microsoft Teams*

- *The Robin now features an 'Audio boost' function to increase the sound output by approx. 6db*
- *The Security settings page has an extra field is added for password verification*
- *The Robin Keypad now features a volume slider for keypad beep sound*

Fixed bugs

- *Fixed an issue with Skype for Business where the connection was lost when using the Robin in Trunk-mode*
- *Fixed a bug in the NAT-option in the Robin that could prevent successful registration to some VoIP providers / remote PBXs*
- *Fixed an issue where the Microsoft Edge browser didn't show video of the Robin SV camera*
- *In the Event mechanism of the Robin, the 'Button' event did not work as designed. This is now fixed*

- *Robin devices equipped with a keypad can use the green call symbol to call the default programmed preset (like the 'i' button on the keypad)*
- *The settings of Robin devices equipped with a keypad can be brought back to application defaults the same way as the other Robin devices*
- *The API of Robin Devices now supports token based authentication*
- *TCP keep-alive sysctl is now set to 180 sec*

Fixed bugs

- *Fixed an issue that prevented a video call made to a hunt group on the Broadsoft- (KPN één, RoutIT) platforms*
- *Fixed an issue where the video image show to a user wasn't displayed properly*
- *Fixed an issue when using passwords long passwords for the 'admin' or 'user'- user*

 - Preset list

 - PIN code feature, get access by typing a PIN code
 - Programmable Info - 'I' button
- Picture to e-mail - Send an e-mail containing a picture made by the camera of a Robin SmartView to a predefined e-mail address, eg. the person operating the Robin. This feature can be selected as an event-action in the Event mechanism of the Robin
- Quality of Service support - Selectable DSCP classes for audio, video and SIP
- Separate RTP port ranges for audio and video
- The Robin API is extended. New API calls are supported, related to SIP settings, video and call logs. See the document 'How-To_Remote_Control_v3.5.0ENG.pdf' on our support site for in-depth information about the Robin API.
- Recording4All support has ended
- Registration / Activation no longer needed

Fixed bugs

- Fixed a bug where the RTSP stream couldn't be set up correctly
- Fixed two Internet Explorer 11 bugs:
 - A Java script error was repeatedly displayed (Curvy Corners)
 - Video of the Robin SV's build in camera was not displayed
- Fixed a bug where Firefox could repeatedly display an authentication window
- Fixed a bug that caused error lines in the Robin Log when a WebRelay Quad LS is used
- Fixed a bug that caused 'Database saved x times in 60 sec' lines in the log file

- New Action added to the Events Menu. IQ-Messenger action, for integration with the IQ Messenger system

Fixed bugs

- Fixed Internet Explorer compatibility. The GUI layout is fixed.
- Changed speaker volume and microphone level setting
- Video performance update
- Possible crash when using RTSP fixed

Known problems

- When using an API command to switch Switch one or Switch two on a Robin HV, a warning line is printed in the log. The command itself works.
